This is an antique county map of Buckinghamshire. An English, framed atlas engraving reproduction by Dutchman Joan Blaeu, dating to the 17th century and later.

- Skilfully charted by the Dutch cartographer Joan Blaeu (1596 - 1673)
- Blaeu was the official cartographer of the Dutch East India Company

• Cherub figures accentuate the scale, shown in 'Milliaria Anglica' - Latin for an English mile
