This is a large antique carved coffer. An English, oak blanket or linen chest, dating to the William III period, circa 1700. A splendid example of early 18th century craftsmanship, offering superb storage and richly detailed carving.

- Select oak stocks present fine grain interest with a deep caramel colour throughout
  - Three-plank lid braced to the reverse for enhanced rigidity and longevity
  - Iron clasp secures the lid, complete with sliding cover – a charming period feature
  - Interior hosts a candle box with lidded top, doubling as a convenient rest when the main lid is raised
- Fascia adorned with exceptional relief carvings, displaying a demi-lune motif across the apron line
    - Classic field panels decorated with diamond-form carvings, adding strong visual appeal
    - Engraved IT monogram to the lower edge, enhancing collector and historical interest
    - Raised upon a quartet of stile feet, offering stability and elegance
    - Could be situated in the lounge as a distinctive coffee table centrepiece
