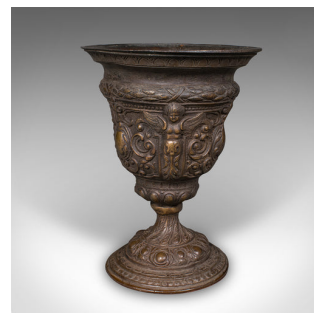
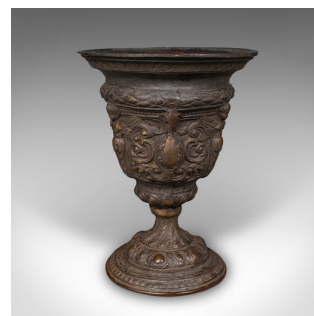


## Antique Grand Tour Planter, Italian, Bronze, Bouquet Vase, Urn, Early Victorian
