This is an antique Grand Tour planter. An Italian, bronze decorative bouquet vase dating to the early Victorian period, circa 1850. A delightful piece of Grand Tour craftsmanship, rich with classical charm and fine ornamental detail.

- Solid bronze body presenting a deep, time-worn patina consistent with age
- Broad, flared rim gracefully tapering to a narrower waist and defined footer
- Fascia adorned with relief cast Putti, adding superb visual interest and classical allure
 - Cabochon motif brings an additional decorative flourish to the surface
 - Stands upon a tapering circular foot, finished with lobe and bead detailing
- \bullet Substantial and well-balanced at 4.066kg (8.96 lb) an appealing display piece for flowers, foliage, or as a sculptural ornament
 - Dressed to the base with a leather cushion for surface protection
