


Antique Display Bookcase, English, Glazed Book Cabinet, Home Library, Victorian

This is an antique display bookcase. An English, mahogany glazed two-door book cabinet, dating to the late Victorian period, circa 1900.

- Attractive figuring to the top, presenting as an ideal display or lamp surface
- Tiered crown moulding projects confidently above the whole, adding architectural presence

- Pair of glazed doors provide a bright window onto the contents
- Dressed with a working lock to the right-hand door — key present
- Doors open to reveal three removable or height-adjustable shelves, each with a useful 22.5cm depth (8.75")

- Interior offers excellent versatility for books, porcelain, curios or display arrangements

- Standing securely upon a continuous plinth foot, with a panelled reverse for a refined finish
