This is an antique display bookcase. An English, mahogany glazed two-door book cabinet, dating to the late Victorian period, circa 1900.

- \bullet Doors open to reveal three removable or height-adjustable shelves, each with a useful 22.5cm depth (8.75")

- Standing securely upon a continuous plinth foot, with a panelled reverse for a refined finish
