This is an antique free-standing fire basket. An English, cast iron, brass and steel decorative hearth in Georgian revival taste, dating to the late Victorian period, circa 1900. A wonderful example of period craftsmanship, presenting a balanced form, attractive detailing, and appealing material contrast. The proportion and form is ideal for the traditional fireside.

- Attractive example with useful proportion, the fire basket displays a robust cast iron body, enriched with steel and brass finishes
- The decorative back rest is adorned with a relief cast frieze, featuring foliate and scroll motif
- Presented in the Georgian manner, lending historic and decorative interest to the form
- Accentuated with a pair of brass finials, standing proudly above the grate in warm golden hues
- Bow-front steel bars to the fascia display a pleasing natural patina, and help keep the contents within the grate
- Eye-catching brass apron situated across the lower edge offers a final flourish of period refinement
