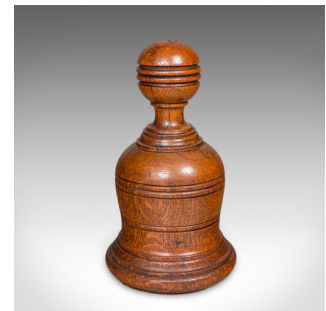


Antique Turned Doorstop, Scottish, Oak, Country House, Door Keeper, Victorian
