- Displays a desirably patinated, time-worn appearance throughout
- Quality tanned leather offers warm caramel hues and appealing texture
 - Robust construction with oak staves to the base, copper rivets and leather corner cappings

- Lid bears the name of a former owner, V. E. Sturgess, with other details redacted
- The top ably secured by a pair of long leather straps and a central sliding clasp
- Crafted in brass, the clasp slider hosts an inset lock – untested, key absent

- Interior presents pleasing cleanliness, lined in a gently aged cream canvas
- Includes a removable tray insert fitted with quality leather carry straps
