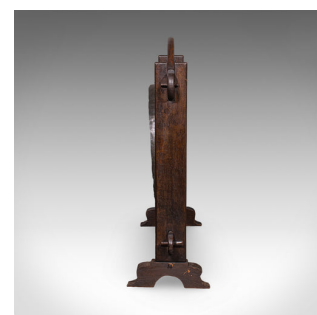


Antique Dinner Hall Gong, Oriental, Bronze Chime, Country House, Edwardian, 1910

This is an antique dinner hall gong. An Oriental, country house fruitwood stand with bronze chime and cork ball striker, dating to the Edwardian period, circa 1910. A charming and evocative piece with excellent visual and aural appeal.

- Cork ball striker, dressed with a leather strap for resting upon the frame
- Standing securely upon a pair of shaped bracket feet
