This is an antique writing table. An English, mahogany scribe's desk, dating to the Regency period, circa 1820. A superbly proportioned example, ideally suited for modern use while retaining authentic period character.

 - Generous internal compartment concealed behind a faux drawer fascia
 - Writing surface set at a useful modern height of 81cm (32")
