This is a pair of vintage botanical pictures. A Japanese, framed woodblock print in the manner of Keika Hasegawa, dating to the late 20th century, circa 1980.

Hasegawa published woodcuts in a series of three volumes known as One Hundred Chrysanthemums by Keika in 1893.

- Attractive decorative duo with Japanese characters and text
- Presenting a desirable aged patina and in good original order
- Each set within an appealing frame with gilt finish
- Displayed behind clear, bright glass for ease of viewing
- Each presents a study of a plant species, with names given in Japanese characters
- The subjects, skilfully illustrated show examples of Chrysanthemums
- The taxonomical name is also Romanised in Nihon-shiki transliteration
- Dressed to the rear with hanging braid for ease of display
