This is an antique turner's armchair. An English, oak Old Saxon elbow seat, dating to the late Victorian period, circa 1890.

- Strikingly distinctive form in the manner of the 'Old Saxon' chair
- Displaying a desirable aged patina and in good original order
- Quality oak stocks present fine grain interest and wisps of medullary rays
- The chair presented in a warm caramel hue throughout
- Superb shape, with the triangular motif and impressively thick stocks
- Profusely engraved back rest, the pattern repeated upon the reverse
- Dramatic angled bobbin turned arms meet pleasingly thick supports
- Legs united with turned stretchers and adjoined with a pair of front rails

This is a delightful antique turner's armchair, with a pleasingly distinctive appearance redolent of the original 17th century example. Solid joints and construction, delivered ready for the home.
