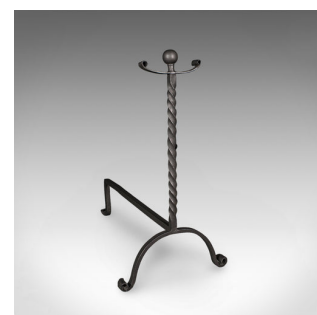


Large Pair of Antique Fireplace Andirons, English, Fire Dog, Victorian, C.1860
