This is an antique Gothic revival sewing case. A Scottish, walnut and brass work box, dating to the Victorian period, circa 1870.

- Delightful Gothic overtones from the revered Scottish revival period
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in good original order
- Select walnut stocks present fine grain interest
- Warm caramel and biscuit hues dance across the fine casework
- Lid adorned with superb brass quarterfoil plate and four corner mounts
- Later silver plated shield engraved with a monogram and the year 1887
- Fascia hosts a shaped lock escutcheon with inset working lock – key present
- Striking silk cotton interior lining finished in a rich scarlet hue
- The interior catches the eye with a buttoned finish, hosting cobalt blue sequins
