This is an antique baronial settle. A Scottish, carved oak reception hall bench with storage, dating to the Victorian period, circa 1870.

- Superior estate piece, with wonderful carved motif and bold figural form
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in good order throughout
- Fine Scottish oak with deep caramel hues and appealing grain interest
- Arranged as a generous two seat bench with a tall back rest
- Profusely carved crest rail, with demi-lune fan motif and scrolled leaf brackets
- Field panel finish to the back rest with diamond decoration and chased pattern carvings
- Exceptional arms, realised as striking seated lions, with prominent head and bold toe detail
- Wide bench enclosed within the arms, providing comfortable reception seating at a height of 49cm
- Bench lid opens to a useful storage recess, ideal for walking boots, shoes and blankets
