This is an antique lowboy. An English, walnut correspondence or scholar's table, dating to the Georgian period, circa 1760. A charmingly composed personal desk, with excellent colour and craftsmanship.

- Displays an attractive, desirably aged patina and in good order throughout
- Classically arranged with a long drawer above a trio of short drawers

- Each drawer fascia hosts brass drop handles, set upon iconic batwing backplates
 - Serpentine shaped apron above a comfortable knee-hole adding to the refined Georgian style
- Standing upon a quartet of tall tapering legs terminating in splayed pad feet
- Of a versatile size, equally suited to a hallway, reception room or study
