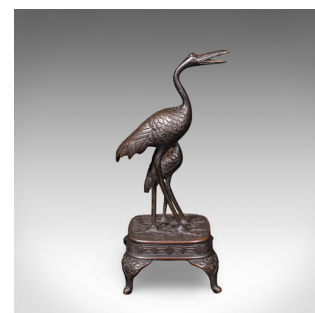
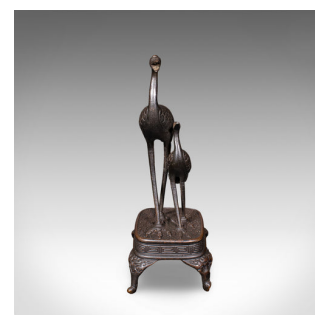
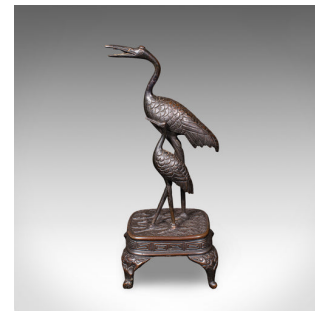


Vintage Okimono Figure, Two Cranes, Japanese, Bronze, Bird Study, Art Deco, 1940
