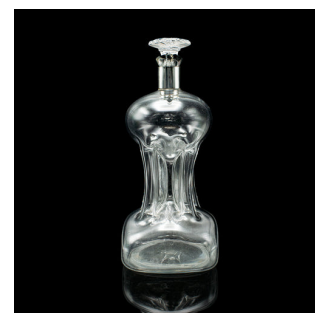
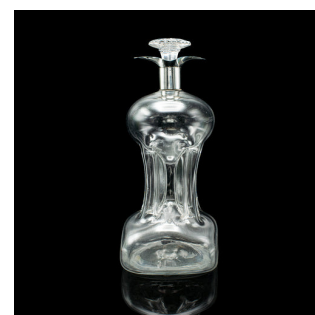


Antique Spirit Decanter, English, Glass, Silver, Port, Brandy Bottle, Edwardian
