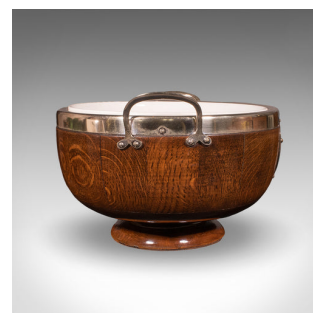


Antique Presentation Prize Bowl, English, Oak, Ceramic, Fruit Dish, Edwardian
