This is an antique map of Scotland. A French, maple framed cartography engraving by Jean-Baptiste Nolin, this posthumous atlas edition dating to the Georgian period, circa 1780.

- A finely detailed, early 18th century national map, rich in historical and decorative appeal
- Displays a desirable aged patina and presented in gently time worn order
- Presented within a tasteful maple frame offering clear protective glazing
- Dressed to the rear with hanging wire for ease of display
- Jean-Baptiste Nolin (1657-1708) was a successful map maker in the late 17th century
- Later atlas edition published posthumously by his eponymous son
- Detailed engraving with period place names and annotated in French
- Superb decorative and informative interest for Scots or collectors
