This is an antique map of Ireland. A French, maple framed cartography engraving by Jean-Baptiste Nolin, this posthumous atlas edition dating to the Georgian period, circa 1780.

- A precisely detailed, early 18th century national map, rich in historical and decorative appeal

- Jean-Baptiste Nolin (1657-1708) was a successful map maker in the late 17th century
