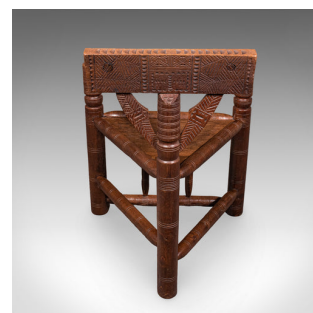


Antique Turner's Armchair, English, Old Saxon Chair, Oak, Elbow Seat, Victorian
