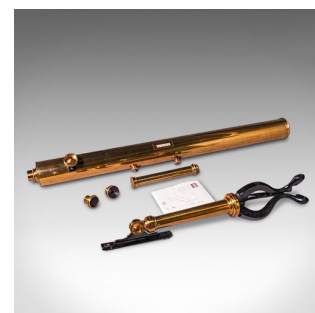


Vintage Library Telescope, English, Brass, Broadhurst Clarkson, Astronomical

This is a vintage cased library telescope. An English, brass 'Starboy' astronomical mounted refractor by Broadhurst, Clarkson & Co, dating to the early 20th century, circa 1930.

- Original primary barrel in good order with light markings under close inspection

- Generously sized, the objective has a bright, 3" diameter (7.5cm)
 - Single draw tube extends smoothly, focused by knurled wheel moving an internal rack and pinion
