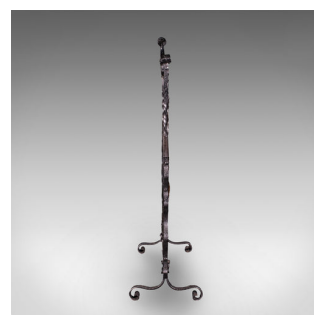


Antique Fire Screen, Art Nouveau, French, Fireplace Reflector, Copper, Victorian
