- Cast iron presented with a deep black painted finish throughout
- Reassuring weight in the hand at 13.2kg (29.1 lb)
- Suitable for use within the entrance hall or besides the front door
- 11cm (4.25") wide scrape situated between a pair of column supports
- Pair of mounting holes cast into the base, for secure fixture
- Illegible maker's mark cast to the underside with pattern number 47
