This is an antique bootmaker's last and gentleman's riding boot duo. An English, leather over beech gentleman's riding boot and stretcher set by Maxwell of Dover Street, dating to the early 20th century, circa 1920. Superb craftsmanship from London's oldest remaining bootmaker, holder of royal patronage and offering bespoke footwear for military and equestrian needs.

- Each boot rests gracefully, with a traditional equestrian form - in UK size 10 (EU 45)
- Displaying a gentle time-worn appearance, and excellent presentation quality throughout
- Fine black leather presents a gently worn, supple patina, rich with antique appeal
- Perfect for decorative retail display, equestrian interiors, or collectors of gentleman's outfitter memorabilia

- Four-section beech stretchers within each boot preserve the shape and condition beautifully
- Ingenious tongue and groove system allows each section to remain securely within the boot
- Central section with handle using a naturally sprung system for locking into place between the outer sections
