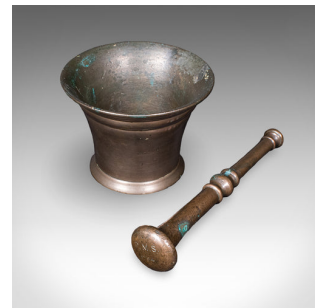


## Antique Chemist's Counter Mortar & Pestle, English, Bronze, Apothecary, Georgian
