This is an antique Meiji table box. A Japanese, lacquer loose leaf tea case, dating to the late Victorian period, circa 1900.

- Wonderful example of Japanese craftsmanship, with rich colour and practicality
- Displays a desirable aged patina, and in good original order
- Lacquered case presented in deep brown with contrasting scarlet red interiors
- Gilt accents adorn each fascia with a delicate, hand-applied finish
- Graced with a suite of drawers across the upper and lower fascia, in addition to the interior
- Lidded compartment to the sarcophagus form top, replete with removable tray – key absent
- Two small upper drawers over one long in the lower fascia
- Each drawer dressed with brass drop handles over shaped backplates
- Pair of doors with ebonised panels, hosting Bodhi icons in gilt painted finish
