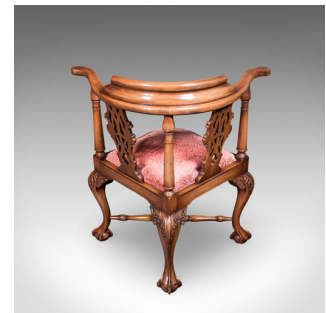
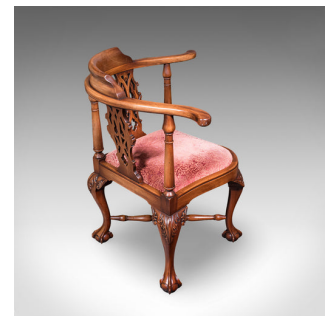


## Antique Corner Armchair, English, Dressing Seat, Georgian Revival, Edwardian
