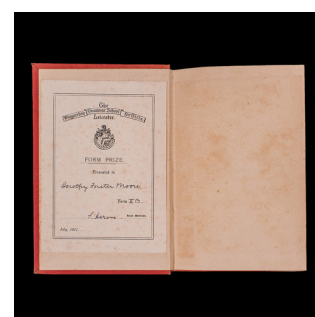


Antique Reference Book, The Outdoor World, English, Natural Interest, George V
