This is a pair of antique mounted horse rider bookends. An English, polished bronze and cast iron figural book rest, dating to the late Victorian period, circa 1890.

• Represents two riders in military dress - one appears to be infantry, and the other an officer

- Later lead weight applied to the base, with scope for use as distinctive door stops
- Good weight in the hand at 3.388kg and 3.190kg respectively (7.469 lb, 7.03 lb)
