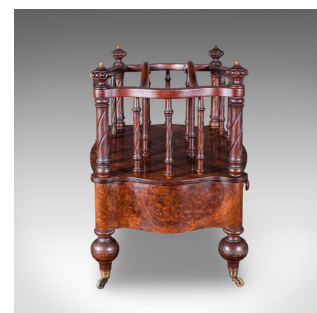


Antique Canterbury Stand, English, Burr Walnut, Newspaper, Magazine, Regency
