This is an antique Cambridge doctor's smoking cabinet. An English, oak and cedar smoker's case, dating to the Edwardian period, circa 1910.

- Fine cabinetry, with the added interest of being presented to a Cambridge-based doctor

- Displays a desirable aged patina and in good order throughout
- Superb oak stocks present fine grain interest and an abundance of medullary rays
- The whole graced with a delightful warm caramel coloration

- Engraved shield cartouche to the top, as presented to a Dr. George A Johnson
- Gifted from an appreciative former patient to commemorate his service from 1906 - 1928

- Pair of cabinet doors enclose the case, with a pair of unmarked shields to the fascia
- Dressed with an inset, brass-lined lock – in working order, key present

- Fitted interior offers a trio of cedar lined drawers, dressed with drop handles over pierced batwing backplates
