This is an antique pole screen. An English, rosewood and glass embroidered fireside heat reflector, dating to the William IV period, circa 1835.

- A fine example showcasing excellent craftsmanship and exceptional decorative interest

- Displays a desirable aged patina - in good order, with one small loss to the reverse
- Select stocks present fine grain interest and bask in deep russet hues
- Shield shape panel adorned with quality relief scallop shell motif

- Glass panel offers a clear, bright view of the embroidery within
- Needlepoint scene depicts a foliate wreath, with fine detail and wonderful colour
- Screen height adjustable through 65cm, ideal for managing heat or display
- Brass vernier to the reverse tightens securely upon the support to hold the panel in place

- Striking barley twist motif accentuates the support stand, with cup and collar forms
