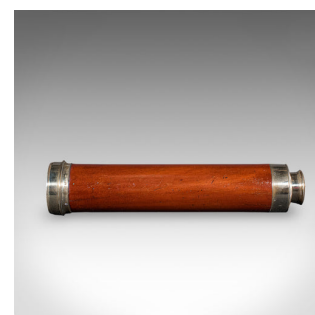
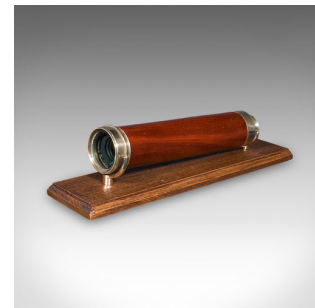




## Large Antique 4 Draw Telescope, English, Maritime Spyglass, W Harris, William IV

This is a large antique four draw telescope. An English, brass and mahogany terrestrial or maritime spyglass, dating to the William IV period, circa 1835.
