This is a vintage 18th century street map of London. An English, framed reproduction showing the parishes of St Clement's Danes and St Mary Savoy, dating to the late 20th century, circa 1980.

Full title: A Mapp of the Parishes of St. Clements Danes; St. Mary Savoy; with the Rolls Liberty and Lincolns Inn, taken from the survey with corrections and additions.

- Fine London interest, as it stood when surveyed in the mid 18th century
- Presented behind clear bright glass and mounted within a tasteful blue card border
- Displays a desirable aged patina, and in good order
- Dressed to the rear with mounting wire for ease of hanging

- Title given within a decorative cartouche to the upper corner

- Maps the legal heartland of Lincoln's Inn, one of the four inns of court
- Other points of interest being the Savoy hospital and The Strand
