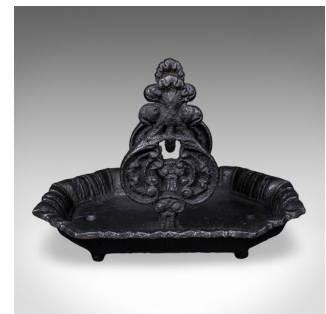


## Antique Townhouse Boot Scraper, English, Shoe Pull, Cleaner, Georgian, C.1800
