This is an antique hospital engraving. An English, framed lithograph of medical interest, dating to the Georgian period and later, circa 1755.

- Presented behind clear, bright protective glass
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in good order throughout

- Scene originally drawn and engraved circa 1755 on behalf of John Tuff Esquire
- A controversial figure, as the Treasurer he absconded with £4000 of the hospital's money

- This syphoning of funds saw the featured East Wing development to be abandoned

- Strong architectural detail with excellent clarity to the hospital frontage
