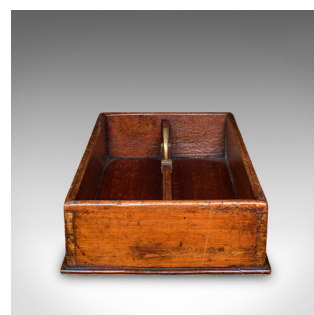


Antique Butler's Work Box, English, Country House Tool Carry, Georgian, C.1790
