This is an antique cocktail cabinet. An English, mahogany and cast iron Great Exhibition era drinks stand in Egyptian revival taste, dating to the early Victorian period, circa 1850.

- Rare and delightfully fascinating, with a distinctive aesthetic finish
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in good original order
- Select stocks present fine grain interest and rich caramel hues
- Arranged as a top cabinet with a pair of drawers beneath a faux fascia
- Unusual form, with canted corners, the front pair hosting Egyptian Queen busts in cast iron
- Lid opens back through 180 degrees, revealing a deep interior
- Pair of removable shelves offering space for bottles below, or a set of drinking glasses
- The interior height of 31cm easily accommodates whiskey decanters or Demi-sized bottles
- Fascia presented as drawers, the upper two being a decorative, faux panel
