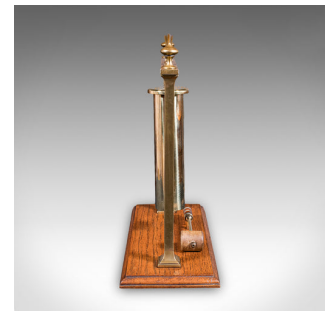


Antique Veranda Supper Bell, Brass, Oak, Afternoon Tea Gong, Edwardian, C.1910
