This is an antique Woodblock picture. A Japanese, framed print in the manner of Utagawa Kunisada II, dating to the late Victorian period, circa 1900.

- Striking Edo period inspired artwork, with delightful colour and detail

- Set within a tasteful later frame, with mounting wire to the reverse
- Female figures with superb costume detail, walking beneath umbrellas

- After Utagawa Kunisada II (1786 - 1865), representing affluent Edo-period figures (1603 - 1868)
- Original woodblocks inspired by the 11th century Japanese novel The Tale of Genji
