- Quality woodblock detail, printed on paper in a distinctive colour palette
- Mounted within a tasteful later frame, with hanging wire to the reverse
- Presents the Yugyoji Temple in Fujisawa during the mid 19th century
- Prominent Torii gate in the foreground, used to denote the entrance to a shrine
- Specifically, its the head of the path to the island shrine of Enoshima Benzaiten
- Travellers on pilgrimage cross the Daigiri Bridge over the Sakai River
