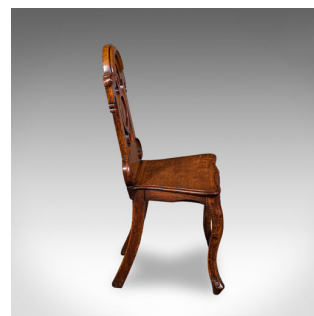


Antique Reception Hall Chair, Scottish, Oak, Side, Occasional Seat, Victorian

This is an antique reception hall chair. A Scottish, golden oak side or occasional seat, dating to the early Victorian period, circa 1840.

- Striking in form and colour, with superb craftsmanship and elegant presence
- Delightful early Victorian chair, perfect for the reception hall or entranceway
 - Scottish oak stocks present superb grain interest, accentuated with wisps of medullary rays
 - Displays a warm, caramel tone and lightly aged patina consistent with period character

- Graceful domed crest rail rises proudly above the distinctively shaped back rest
- Adorned with a fascinating fretwork centre, the back splat hosts a circular motif
- Bobbin turned finials and scroll motif add visual interest to the back rest

- Wide seat squab set at a comfortable height of 44cm (17.25"), offering practicality alongside aesthetic appeal
- Attractive cabriole legs to the fore with a serpentine shaped apron
