This is an antique Woodblock picture. A Japanese, framed ukiyo-e colour print in the manner of Keisai Eisen, dating to the late Victorian period, circa 1900.

- Striking Edo period artwork, reproduced with delightful colour and detail
- Presents a desirable aged patina and in good order throughout
- Fine woodblock detail, printed on paper in appealing colour
- Set within a tasteful later frame, with mounting wire to the reverse
- Female courtesans with superb costume detail, reading scrolls
- Background features an inset landscape view of a boat on water
- After Keisai Eisen (1790- 1848), representing affluent Edo-period figures (1603 - 1868)
 - From his series A Tokaido Board Game of Courtesans: Fifty-three Pairings in the Yoshiwara
 - Original woodblocks created in the 1820s, featuring the figures Michinoku and Michiuta
