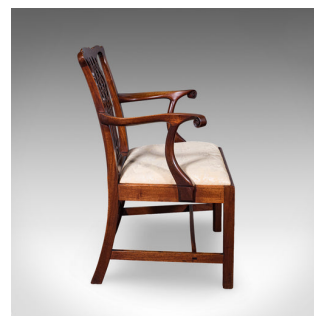


Antique Gentleman's Elbow Chair, English, Morning Room Seat, Georgian, C.1800
