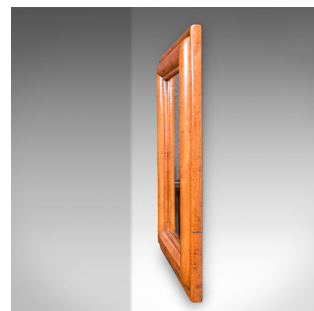


Antique Reception Hall Vanity Mirror, English, Walnut, Bevelled Glass, Edwardian
