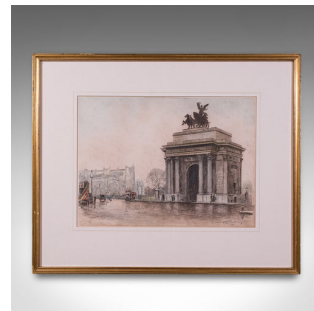


Antique Framed London Picture, Constitution Hill, English, Art Print, Circa 1925

This is an antique London etching of Constitution Hill. An English, framed print by Eugene Tily (1870 - 1937) after the original by Edward King, dating to the Art Deco period and later, circa 1925.

- Delightful limited edition print, showing the Wellington Arch at Constitution Hill
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in good order
- Quality later frame, with card mount and attractive gilt frame finish
- Dressed to the rear with hanging wire for ease of mounting

• A colour-washed copperplate etching by Eugene Tily after the original by Edward King

• Presents the Wellington Arch in the 1920s, with contemporary red London busses
 • Running from the western edge of Buckingham Palace, Constitution Hill terminates with the Arch at Hyde Park Corner

- Set after a rain shower, with the slick, wet road reflecting the arch and surroundings
- Imprint to paper added by the Museum Galleries to signify the limited run of prints
