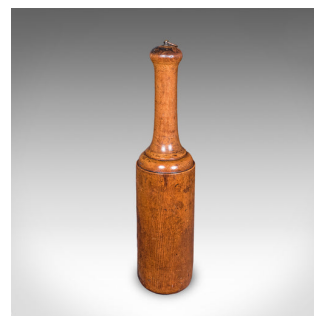


Antique Steak Tenderiser, English, Beech, Treen, Kitchen Mallet, High Victorian
